The visit will include a discussion of the purpose and effects of the care provided within the MAZ and a brief visit to the treatment unit.



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










ART works from a recovery-oriented approach, emphasizing the client's abilities and strengths. This means there is a lot of attention to the client's personal goals and wishes, and close collaboration with family and other involved parties. 



Magnolia is a residential center for the mostly older people who need intensive 24-hour care due to psychiatric problems, often in combination with somatic health issues. The treatment and guidance focus on maintaining stabilization and skills, ensuring a high quality of life, with well-being and happy living at the forefront. There is a strong emphasis on health and a healthy lifestyle



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

Program:

Opening by the Head of Social Development (MO) of the municipality of 's-Hertogenbosch with a welcome speech and outline the challenges we aim to tackle together.

Introduction by the Project Leader of the Coordination Point for Persons with Unexplained Behavior and Risk.

A deep dive into the issues surrounding individuals with confused (unexplained) behavior and the risks associated with it, focusing on solutions and collaboration opportunities.
