You will get acquainted with an Early Intervention Psychosis team in the Netherlands. The VIP team treats (young) adults with a first or second psychosis. We use our specialist knowledge of psychosis for diagnostics, prevention, early detection and treatment based on scientific knowledge. Magnolia is a residential center for the mostly older people who need intensive 24-hour care due to psychiatric problems, often in combination with somatic health issues. The treatment and guidance focus on maintaining stabilization and skills, ensuring a high quality of life, with well-being and happy living at the forefront.
